

Dear Taxpayer:

This is in response to your Oct. 22, 2012, request for information regarding your tax-exempt status.

Specifically, section 6033(j) of the Code provides that failure to file an annual information return for three consecutive years results in revocation of tax-exempt status as of the filing due date of the third return for organizations required to file.
